Crown Castle NG Central LLC (formerly known as Crown Castle NG Central Inc.) (the "Company") hereby notifies the Commission that the Company's current name is "Crown Castle NG Central LLC" as a result of its conversion from a Delaware corporation to a Delaware limited liability company. The conversion of the Company to a limited liability company was merely a change in its corporate form accomplished through the filing of Certificate of Conversion in Delaware and did not entail any merger or other transactions that extinguish the existence of the Company. The Company, therefore, requests that the records of the Commission, including the Company's Certificate,¹ be updated to reflect its current name, "Crown Castle NG Central LLC." ORDER

On August 13, 2013, Crown Castle NG Central Inc. ("Crown Castle" or "Company") filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide resold and facilities-based local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Arkansas. Crown Castle supplemented or amended its application on September 19, 2013. It filed a proposed tariff with its application.

On November 11, 2013, Mr. Bill Dennis, Manager of the Telecommunications and Quality of Service Section for the General Staff of the Arkansas Public Service Commission, filed testimony stating the application is in compliance with Section 7.05 of the Commission's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*, and he recommended granting Crown Castle a CCN to provide local and intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Arkansas.

Mr. Dennis recommended directing Crown Castle to maintain a current tariff or price list with the Commission. In addition he recommended Crown Castle be directed to maintain maps and legal descriptions of the geographic areas to be served, or to place statements in its tariff or price list concurring in the appropriate exchange area maps

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and boundary descriptions filed with the Commission. He stated that, if the geographical area served by the Company changes, it should be directed to amend its tariff or price list to reflect the new area served. Mr. Dennis further recommended directing the Company to participate in the Arkansas Intrastate Carrier Common Line Pool; to comply with all applicable statutes and Commission Rules, including but not limited to: Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-3-109, 23-2-308, 23-3-110, and 23-3-112, which require the Company to provide an annual report to the Commission, including gross earnings, by March 31 of each year and to pay an annual fee; and to comply with Rule 7.13.D of the *Telecommunications Providers Rules*, which requires the Company to provide certain information to the Commission's Consumer Services Office.

The parties waived a hearing pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §23-3-205.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Company be, and is hereby, granted a CCN to provide local and intrastate interexchange telecommunications services as a CLEC in Arkansas. The Company is directed to maintain a current tariff or price list with the Commission and to maintain maps and legal descriptions of the geographic areas to be served or to place statements in its tariff or price list concurring in the appropriate exchange area maps and boundary descriptions filed with the Commission. If the geographical area served by the Company changes, it shall amend its tariff or price list to reflect the new area served. The Company shall participate in the Arkansas Intrastate Carrier Common Line Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Company shall comply with all applicable statutes and Commission Rules, including: Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-3-109, 23-2-308, 23-3-110, and 23-3-112, which require the Company to provide an annual report to the


Commission, including gross earnings, by March 31 of each year and to pay an annual fee; and it shall comply with Rule 7.13.D of the *Telecommunications Provider Rules*, which requires the Company to provide certain information to the Commission's Consumer Services Office.
