Crown Castle NG West LLC (formerly known as Crown Castle NG West Inc. and NextG Networks of California Inc. d/b/a NextG Networks West) (the "Company") hereby notifies the Commission that the Company's current name is "Crown Castle NG West LLC" as a result of (1) a name change from "NextG Networks of California Inc. d/b/a NextG Networks West" to "Crown Castle NG West Inc." and (2) its subsequent conversion from a Delaware corporation to a Delaware limited liability company. The conversion of the Company to a limited liability company was merely a change in its corporate form accomplished through the filing of Certificate of Conversion in Delaware and did not entail any merger or other transactions that extinguished the existence of the Company. The Company requests that the Commission update its records, including the Company's Registration, to reflect its current name, "Crown Castle NG West LLC".

(4) A description of the telecommunication services offered by the telephone corporation and a map of the area(s) served by the telephone corporation or in which the telephone corporation offers or intends to offer service

NextG currently intends to offer its service in Eagle, Garden City, Hailey, Ketchum, Salmon, and Sun Valley. However, NextG also will seek to offer its services throughout the entire state of Idaho.

NextG will provide radio frequency ("RF") transport and backhaul services to commercial mobile radio service ("CMRS") providers. NextG also may transport its wireless customer's data services. NextG will provide its services using a system of fiber optic cables and small antennas and conversion equipment attached to poles and other structures. NextG will provide both interstate and intrastate services. At this time, NextG does not intend to furnish residential or business local exchange services or switched, interexchange telephone service.

NextG will only provide RF Transport Services where technology permits. The furnishing of RF Transport Services requires certain physical arrangements of equipment and facilities of NextG and other entities and is subject to the availability of such equipment and facilities and the economic feasibility of providing such necessary equipment and facilities and the RF Transport Services. NextG will offer service subject to the availability of the necessary facilities and/or equipment. NextG will reserve the right not to provide service to or from a location where the necessary facilities or equipment are not available.

The Company's services will be generally provided on a monthly basis and will be available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week, subject to the availability of necessary service, equipment and facilities.

RF Transport Services uses optical technology, including multi-wavelength optical technology over dedicated transport facilities to provide telecommunications companies with more efficient transport and greater overall network service options. RF Transport Services connect customer-provided wireless capacity equipment to customer-provided or NextG provided bi-directional RF-to-optical conversion equipment at a hub facility. The hub facility can be customer or NextG provided. The conversion equipment will allow NextG to accept RF traffic from the customer and then send bi-directional traffic transmission across the appropriate optical networks. At the remote end, NextG or the telecommunications company will provide RF-to-optical conversion equipment to allow bi-directional conversion between optical signals and RF signals. RF signals can be received and radiated at this remote node.

There will be some specific limitations applicable to RF Transport Services, including the following:

- All optical services are provided on single mode optical fiber
- Some optical services may be of a multi-wavelength nature
- Current wireless standards limit the distance between a hub site and a remote node to 20 kilometers
- The optical loss between a hub site and a remote node must not exceed 18dB

NextG intends to reserve the right to discontinue furnishing the service upon its written notice, when necessitated by conditions beyond its control or when the customer is using the service in violation of the law.
